Tasks/Actions

- Leaders to analyse vulnerable pupils' attainment and achievement and work with phase teams to plan for rapid and sustained pupil progress
- To build upon the existing programme of events, trips and visitors
- Staff to receive appropriate training to support children with specific needs
- Where necessary children with specific needs are to have a care plan and risk assessment in place
- Ensure that the physical environment meets the needs of all pupils
- Pupil data to be evaluated to ensure all children are achieving and attaining in line with their peers. Where this is not the case, interventions are to be put in place
- Provision maps are to be regularly updated by the inclusion manager and shared with class teachers

Tasks/Actions

- A wide range of school clubs are to be offered to all children
- Family learning sessions: parents are to be invited into each class on a termly basis
- Parents learning events / workshops to be planned and organised
- Analyse children who are attending the clubs to ensure an inclusive process is in place
- Parents to complete evaluation forms when they attend learning events or open days
- The pastoral team are to continue to work on building relationships and engagement with parent / carers
